## How the Survey was Conducted

## Nature of the Sample: National Survey of 1,690 Adults

This survey of 1,690 adults was conducted September $27^{\text {th }}$ through September $29^{\text {th }}$, 2022 by the Marist Poll. Adults 18 years of age and older residing in the United States were contacted through a multi-mode design: By phone using live interviewers, by text, or online. The sampling frames include RDD plus listed landline, cell phone sample based on billing address to account for inward and outward mobility within a state, and aggregated online research panels. Survey questions were available in English or Spanish. Phone and online samples were selected to ensure that each region was represented in proportion to its population. The samples were then combined and balanced to reflect the 2020 American Community Survey 5 -year estimates for age, gender, income, and race. Regional adjustments were made for turnout in similar elections. Results are statistically significant within $\pm 4.0$ percentage points. There are 1,562 registered voters. The results for this subset are statistically significant within $\pm 4.2$ percentage points. There are 1,293 registered voters who definitely plan to vote in November's election. The results for this subset are statistically significant within $\pm 4.6$ percentage points. Tables include results for subgroups to only display crosstabs with an acceptable sampling error. It should be noted that although you may not see results listed for a certain group, it does not mean interviews were not completed with those individuals. It simply means the sample size is too small to report. The error margin was adjusted for sample weights and increases for cross-tabulations.

## How to Read Banners

'Banners' are a simple way to display tabular data. The following provides an explanation of how to read the banners.

1. Thinking of the entire table as a grid of cells, each cell contains a number. This number gives the percentage of respondents in a column in each cell.
2. Columns read vertically down the page.
3. The table headings present the people, or subgroup, each column represents. They are each noted with a letter.
4. The remaining rows present the column percentages for each valid response category to a question.
5. The banners include notations for statistical significance testing between columns. Each column is labeled with letters. If a capital letter is below a percent, it notes that this percent is statistically different at the $95 \%$ confidence level from the percent of the lettered column. If a lowercase letter is below a percent, it notes this percent is statistically different at the $90 \%$ confidence level from the percent of the lettered column. For example in the table below, the $20 \%$ in column B is statistically different from the $5 \%$ in column C at a $95 \%$ confidence level. Adults living in households that use supplements are statistically more likely to have heard a great deal or a good amount about the legislation before Congress than are adults living in households that do not use supplements.
