

Safeguarding the Freedom to Choose Homeopathy for All Americans

Organizational Overview

Americans for Homeopathy Choice (AFHC) is a national, nonpartisan, nonprofit organization representing the interests of more than six million Americans who regularly rely on homeopathy to restore and maintain their health. We are focused on safeguarding the freedom to choose homeopathy for all Americans.

Our funding comes primarily from consumers of homeopathic medicines: mothers and daughters, fathers and sons, grandfathers and grandmothers, people in all walks of life. In addition, we receive support from health practitioners of all types including medical doctors who prescribe homeopathic medicines for their patients and from pharmacies which manufacture and distribute those medicines.

We have a nationwide group of officers and volunteers who help us spread awareness and gather support for our activities.

We believe modern medicine can co-exist with homeopathy and other traditional healing arts. We think the full array of treatment options should be available to physicians and patients. And, we believe that responsibility for health decisions ought to rest with the adult who is being treated or whose children are being treated.

AFHC was formed in 2018 in response to a conceptually flawed and poorly worded proposal by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration that, if adopted, would lower standards for the manufacture of homeopathic medicines and could lead to bans on broad categories of those medicines due, in part, to a misunderstanding of how homeopathy works.
